Hymn 387 I am Thine, O Lord, I have heard Thy voice

1 I am Thine, O Lord, I have heard Thy voice, And it told Thy love to me; But I long to rise in the arms of faith, And be closer drawn to Thee.

Chorus Draw me nearer, nearer, blessed Lord,
To the cross where Thou hast died;
Draw me nearer, nearer, nearer, blessed Lord,
To Thy precious, bleeding side.

- 2 Consecrate me now to Thy service, Lord, By the pow'r of grace divine; Let my soul look up with a steadfast hope, And my will be lost in Thine.
- 3 O the pure delight of a single hour That before Thy throne I spend, When I kneel in prayer, and with Thee, my God, I commune as friend with friend!
- 4 There are depths of love that I yet may know Ere Thee face to face I see;
 There are heights of joy that I yet may reach Ere I rest in peace with Thee.

Brief Background of the Hymn

We have 19 hymns in our hymnal by the lyric writer of this hymn, Frances Jane Crosby (1820-1915), more commonly known as Fanny Crosby, who was an American mission worker, poet, lyricist, and composer. She was one of the most prolific hymnists in history, writing more than 8,000 hymns and gospel songs. During her life she was known as the "Queen of Gospel Song Writers". Some of Crosby's best-known songs include "Pass Me Not, O Gentle Saviour", "Blessed Assurance", "Jesus Is Tenderly Calling You Home", "Praise Him, Praise Him", "Rescue the Perishing", and "To God Be the Glory".

Fanny was blind her whole life. She was raised by her mother and maternal grandmother and they grounded her in Christian principles, helping her memorize long passages from the Bible. From age 10 she memorized five chapters of the Bible each week; by age 15, she had memorized the four gospels, the Pentateuch, the Book of Proverbs, the Song of Solomon, and many of the Psalms. Later in life she said: "It seemed intended by the blessed providence of God that I should be blind all my life, and I thank him for the dispensation. If perfect earthly sight were offered me tomorrow I would not accept it. I might not have sung hymns to the praise of God if I had been distracted by the beautiful and interesting things about me."

In this hymn, the writer expressed a deep longing to have more intimate fellowship with the Lord. What a blessing to obtain "the pure delight of single hour that before Thy throne I spend"! What a blessing that we can "commune as friend with friend". James 4:8a - Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you...
