Brief Background of the Hymn

Fanny Crosby (1820-1915) was one of the most prolific hymnists in history, writing more than 8,000 hymns and gospel songs. This hymn is considered one of Fanny's best known hymns. In her autobiography, Fanny wrote that this was her first hymn to be set to music by Robert Lowry (1826-1899), who also composed the music for the hymn "I need Thee every hour" (hymn 371 that we introduced before). The hymn was first published in 1875.

Fanny was blind her whole life. When she was in her 80s, she mentioned the process of her blindness in her autobiography: when she was only 6 months old, one day, she had infection to her eyes. Unfortunately, the family doctor was away, and another man—pretending to be a certified doctor—treated her by prescribing hot mustard poultices to be applied to her eyes. The treatment left her blind. When the doctor was revealed to be a quack, he disappeared. Fanny testified that she never hated that doctor. She believed what had happened was God's sovereign arrangement according to His loving and marvelous will, so that she would be sanctified to serve Him until then. It is because Fanny had such a realization that she could wrote this hymn to declare "All the way my Savior leads me; What have I to ask beside? Can I doubt His tender mercy, Who through life has been my Guide? Heav'nly peace, divinest comfort, Here by faith in Him to dwell! For I know, whate'er befall me, Jesus doeth all things well." May this also be our declaration!
