- 1. Church in Lubbock Meeting Hall We would like to present an opportunity to participate in the Lord's move in Lubbock, Texas. Over the past decade, the church life has grown as the Lord has added to our number from the campus, the community, and through migration. Around 150 students actively meet with the campus club, and to date, 35 have attended the FTTA. The need for a meeting hall has become more and more evident, especially with regard to caring for the children and YP. The saints in Lubbock have been praying for some time that the Lord would provide an adequate facility for His move there in Lubbock. Currently, the Lord has made such a facility available. The building is 10,400 square feet on a 1.55 acre lot and has ample parking attached, as well as additional street parking available as needed. The saints in Lubbock have the property under contract, and have until March 21st to raise the necessary funds for the purchase of the property. Besides the funds raised locally from the saints in Lubbock, the remaining need is at around \$1.7 million (Last update 1/27/24). May the Lord continue to bless His move on the earth!
