## Brief Background of the Hymn

This hymn was adapted by brother Watchman Nee, full of spiritual feelings and experiences. 2 Cor. 4:17 says, "For our momentary lightness of affliction works out for us, more and more surpassingly, an eternal weight of glory". When the Lord comes back, the overcomers will reign with Him a thousand years in His kingdom. The way to enter into reigning with Christ in the kingdom, however, is today to "fill up on my part that which is lacking of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for His Body, which is the church". Therefore, brother Nee regarded bearing the Lord's shame and derision and suffering for Him today as blest opportunities. All of us should "treasure these blessings". Through these, we enter into "the fellowship of His sufferings, "(Phil. 3:10) "enter sweet oneness with Thee."

May we all enter into the spirit of this hymn, grasp every opportunity, "For Thee, Lord, to live at all cost", "Lest Thy servant, hoping for that blessed day, That day, regret chances were lost".
